- We have conducted training with our staff members about the necessity of extreme cleanliness and the need for constant hand washing and sanitizing throughout the day at every opportunity and especially between each and every patient interaction
- Our staff training has included an emphasis on sanitizing “High Touch” surfaces frequently
- We are keeping well informed of any current or additional efforts we, as your treating staff, can conduct to further increase what we believe is the Highest Standard of Care and Safety a clinical facility can offer
